

# RMB Tracker Monthly reporting and statistics on renminbi (RMB) progress towards becoming an international currency

In June 2020, the RMB has climbed one position to the fifth most active currency for global payments by value, with a share of 1.76%. Overall, RMB payments value increased by 14.15% compared to May 2020, whilst in general all payments currencies increased by 16.05%.


In terms of international payments excluding payments within the Eurozone, the RMB ranked 8th with a share of 1.14% in June 2020.




## RMB's share as a global payments currency

# RMB's share as an international payments currency – Excluding payments within Eurozone







# Offshore RMB payments evolution






## RMB's share as a global currency in trade finance market


