Incorrect use of the Broadcast message - MT 074

As of November 2014, SWIFT will no longer accept the Broadcast Request message (MT 074) with SSI details. Instead, submitters will be directed to use the Standing Settlement Instruction Update Notification Request message (MT 670). These changes will go into effect with the Standards Release 2014.

To help you prepare and understand these messages (MT 670 and 671), SWIFT Training invites you to attend the half day web class 'Standing Settlement Instructions - Messages and Reference Data'.

The correct usage of these dedicated SSI messages will help you reduce your costs and give your correspondent banking operations an STP boost!
