Are you ready for the BCBS (Basel Committee for Banking Supervision) guidelines to monitor your intra-day liquidity? Did you know that SWIFT figures show that only 20% of all correspondent banking payment instructions exchanged on SWIFT are confirmed with an intra-day debit/credit confirmation message which would allow the bank to calculate liquidity as transfers are made?

Learn about the financial institution transfer messages for bank to bank payments and how you can use the SWIFT cash management and customer status messages for your intra-day liquidity reporting to meet the guidelines of BCBS in this new one-day course. Our instructor will also share possible solutions to meet the BCBS requirements on intra-day liquidity reporting. At the end of the course you have the possibility to do an optional knowledge assessment test which will give you a good indication on how well you have assimilated the newly acquired knowledge.
