




Defining data scope First step in running a dashboard




Navigating in the dashboards Familiarise with the setup of a dashboard (Tabs and Panels)





Filtering in the dashboards Interactive filters using the Filters panel






Filtering in the dashboards Interactive filters using charts (title ends with *)






Exporting data to Excel (1/3) Limited to the data shown in that specific visual






Export data to Excel (2/3) Limited to the data shown in that specific visual
