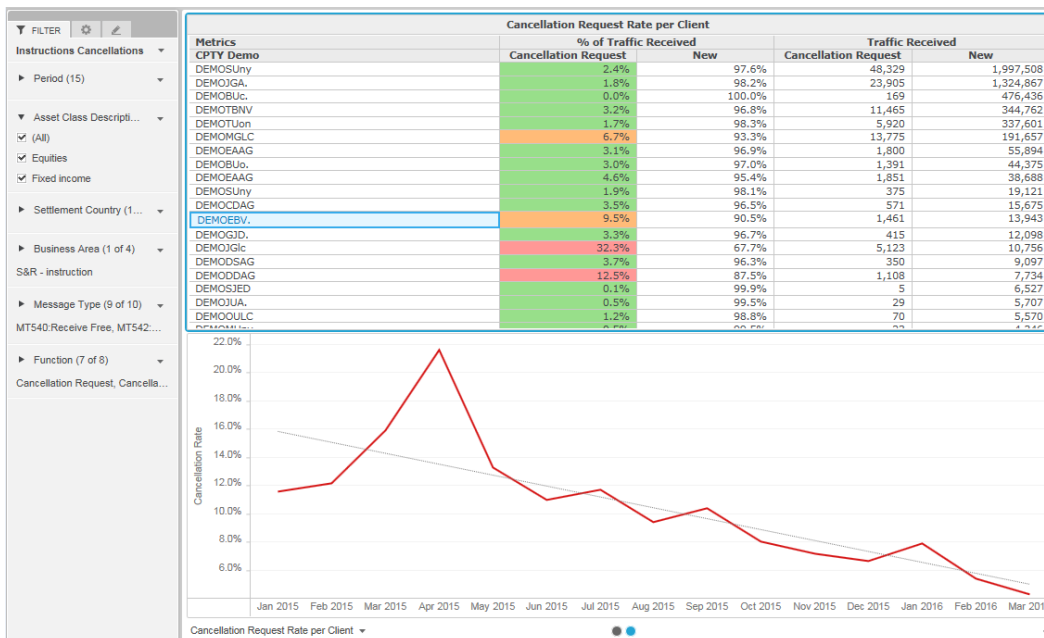
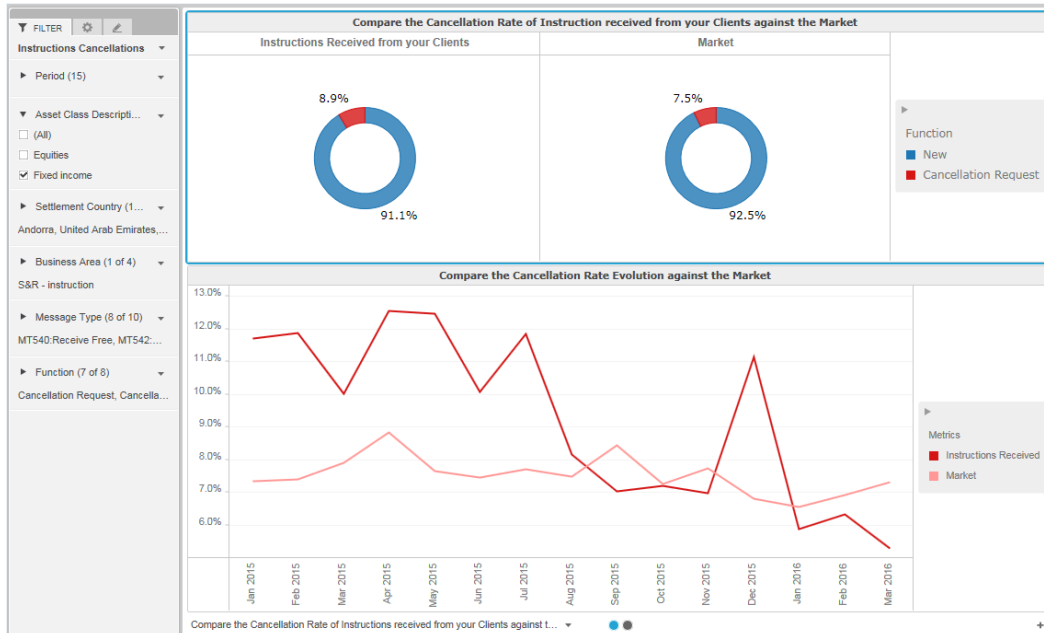

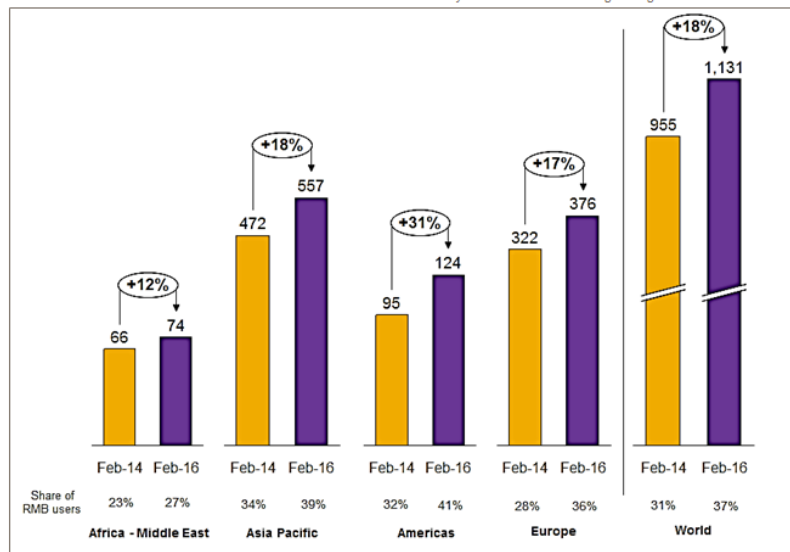

SWIFT's [March RMB Tracker](#) shows an 18% increase in RMB usage by financial institutions worldwide for payments with China and Hong Kong.

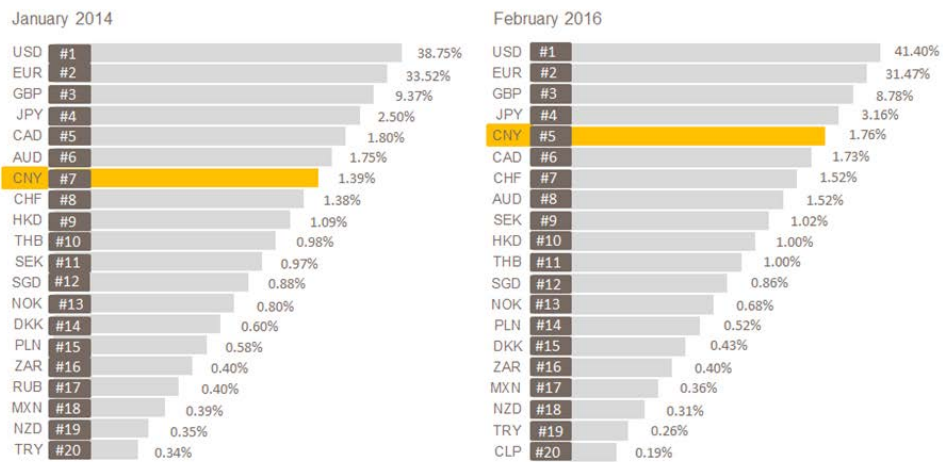
RMB reaches nearly 40% adoption across financial institutions worldwide
