

RMB Tracker Monthly reporting and statistics on renminbi (RMB) progress towards becoming an international currency

In May 2023, the RMB has retained its position as the fifth most active currency for global payments by value, with a share of 2.54%. Overall, RMB payments value increased by 20.38% compared to April 2023, whilst in general all payments currencies increased by 8.75%.

In terms of international payments excluding payments within the Eurozone, the RMB ranked 6th with a share of 1.51% in May 2023.



RMB's share as an international payments currency – Excluding payments within Eurozone










Swift RMB Tracker

Offshore RMB payments evolution




RMB's share as a global currency in trade finance market


