

## WG1 Activity: Credit Transfer and Payment Status Report (Q1 2023)

#### **COMPLETED:**

- ❖ Finalized Appendix B (country specifics) for 39 countries, and sent for final review before publication on Swift MyStandards. Planned implementation start for banks and vendors is Nov. 2023.
- Presented regulatory reporting usage guidelines (part of append.B) to PMPG to familiarize the broader banking community
- Run a webinar to familiarize corporates with the ISO structured address topic and inform about PMPG survey

## WG2 Activity: Cash Management Reporting (Q1 2023)

#### **COMPLETED:**

- Virtual Account guideline supporting the presentation of ultimate parties
- Pagination:
  - Updated Paginated Balance Reporiting guidelines
  - Harmonized multiple-file Paginated use-cases
  - New element-leve best-practices
- Published use-case for Balance availability reporting on Non-Booking Dates

#### **UPCOMING:**

- Publish consolidated WG2 Best-Practice guideline
- Publish new use-cases
- SWIFT camt. Concentrator model (aka "Relay/Multibank Reporting")



### **Approach**

- Harmonized Bank-to-Corporate reporting by providing recommended maps between payment messages and bank reporting
- Provide cross-format guidelines for legacy camt. and other applicable formats, ensuring industry consistency for Corporates who do not migrate to Version 8 yet request Version 2 or other formats.
- Remove Reporting Agent variations by providing reporting best-practice use-cases.
- \*Remove superfluous guidance which were introduced when ISO was novel to the industry.
- Provide unambiguous guidance





# A Common Language for Trade Finance

- Common White Paper <u>Standardised Trust</u> and a <u>LinkedIn community</u> (now 390+ members)
- Standardised Trust Events started in October 2017
- Working Group efforts started in June 2018 with currently 30+ active, mostly European, members participating
- Voluntary and non-budget community of experts
- Creation of common semantic model for Guarantees started in May 2019 and for Documentary Credits in April 2021

# Some Achievements

- A draft Semantic Model for Guarantees and Stand By Letter of Credits (SBLCs)
  - In MS Excel and
  - As JSON Schema
- Next step is to test the semantic model with a variety of Guarantee use cases in its life-cycles
- The upcoming semantic model (including both data model and the use guidelines) can be used openly by any party enabling easy interoperability in data exchange between various processes, systems or platforms
- Documentary Credit (like Letter of Credit) semantic modelling is currently on very early stage
- Documentation (even drafts) available openly at the community OneDrive space
- All new voluntary experts are welcomed!





# Collaboration status and options

- ISO 20022 dependency in the CGI-MP Terms of Reference might need to be changed
  - Availability beyond Payments Domain
  - ISO 20022 dependency
  - Only XML encoding
- Exchange of CGI-MP and Standardised Trust members and their knowledge in various tasks cross the teams
  - Mapping the possibility to add knowledge and resources
  - Evaluating the possible WG #6 creation
  - Analyse the future of Standardised Trust community if we will find a proper way forward


