Customers are not required to use CSP Assessment Providers listed in this Directory and are free to make their own choice regarding use of (i) a suitable *internal* independent assessment function (for example, customer’s compliance or risk management or internal audit function) or (ii) a suitable *external* independent CSP assessment provider of their own choosing, regardless of whether or not listed in the Directory. Each customer must independently conduct its own analysis to determine whether any CSP Assessment Provider or CSP Certified Assessor is suitable for that customer’s needs or purposes, including whether such provider is suitably independent (for example, the provider’s assessment will not be influenced by any other commercial or other relationship it may have with the customer). Any relationship between a customer and a CSP Assessment Provider or a CSP Certified Assessor is independent, and without responsibility or involvement, of Swift.
