- When advising on or implementing payment solutions we always advise to use and follow the CGI standards
- If the scope demands it we advise to organize a XML harmonization session
- In this session the corporate and the involved banks agree on a "global" XML format and agree which mandatory parameters are used
- The goal is to accomplish bank agnosticity from a payment file format perspective
 - Also to reduce the initial implementation effort when more banks in one country are implemented



Implementation Considerations

- Banks are not always fully CGI compliant
 - Even if they claim to be!
- Requesting banks to become CGI compliant can be difficult
 - Banks have different timelines than their clients

 It differs per client how far they push their banks to become CGI compliant



General observations

• CGI is well known amongst corporates

- However, often not all countries which are implemented are already covered by CGI guidelines
 - Little visibility on work in progress

 A huge benefit are the standard CGI templates available in the different ERP systems
