## February 2017

In terms of international payments, compared to December 2016, in January 2017 the RMB kept its position as the sixth most active currency for international payments by value, with a share of 1.68%. RMB payments value decreased by 2.83% compared to December 2016, whilst in general all payments currencies decreased by 2.55%.

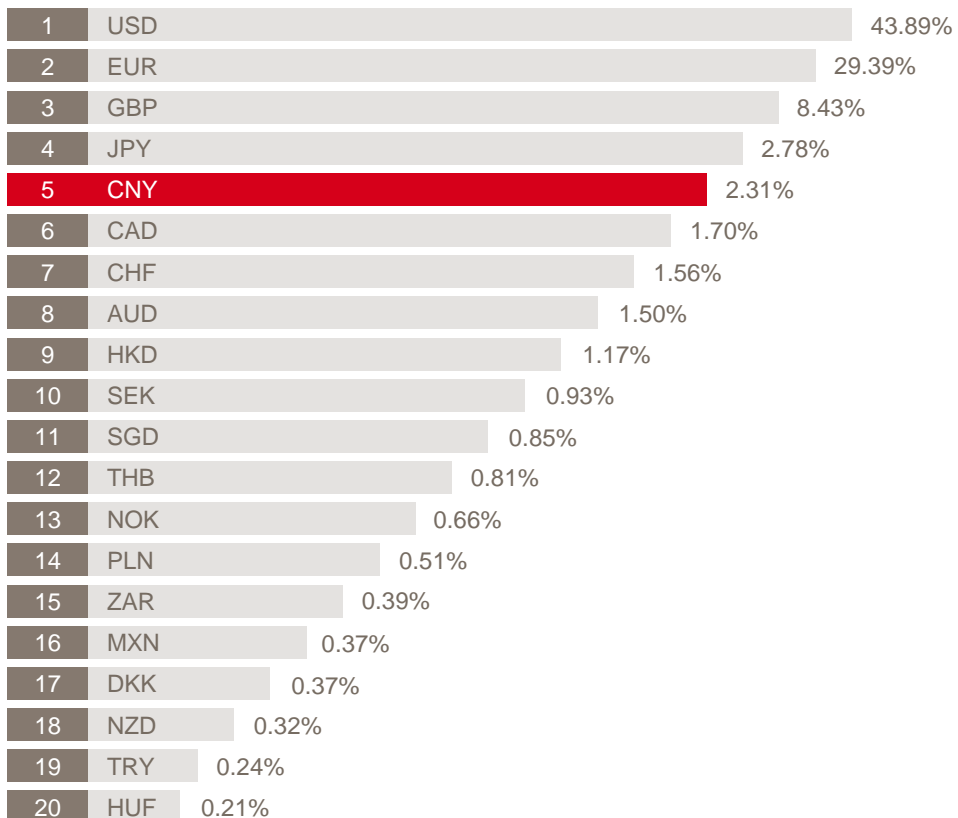


## RMB's share as an international payments currency

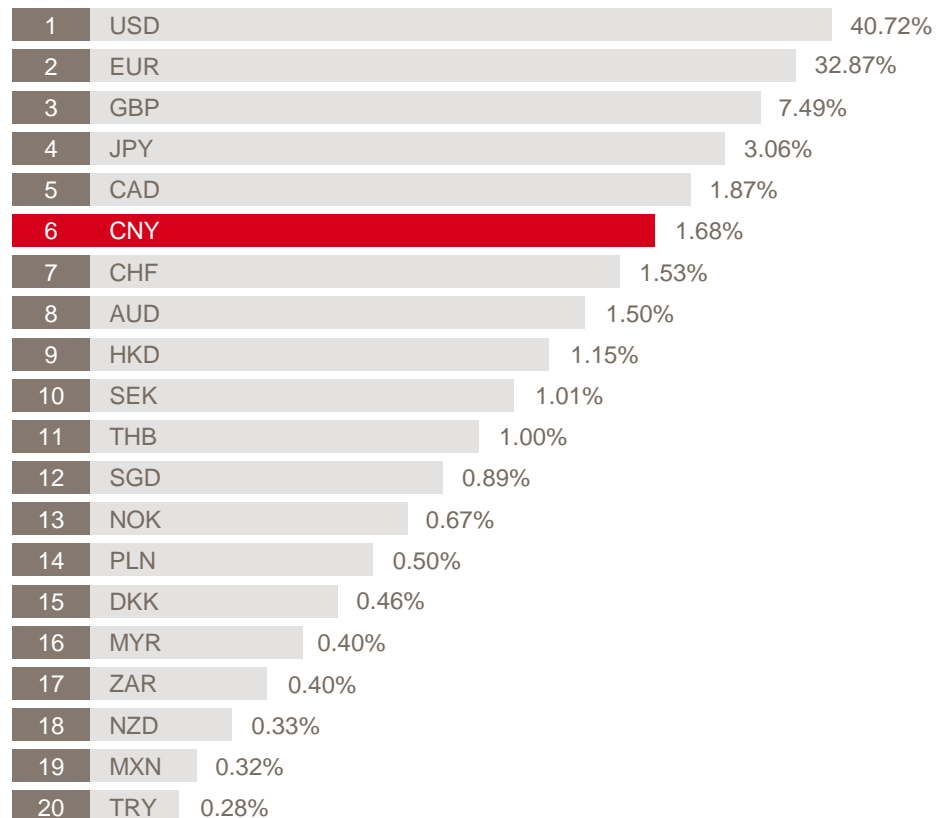

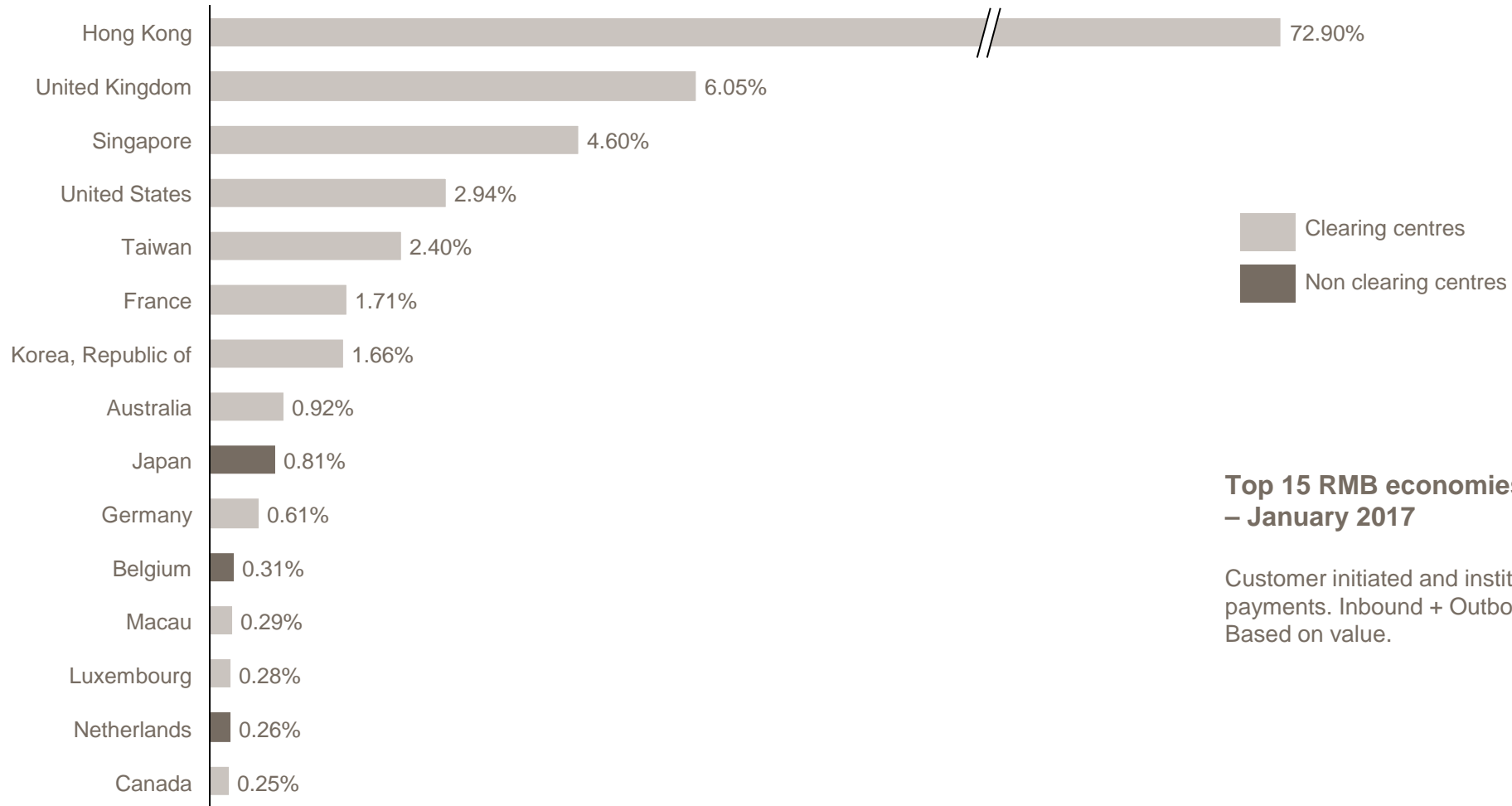

### Top 15 RMB economies by weight – January 2017

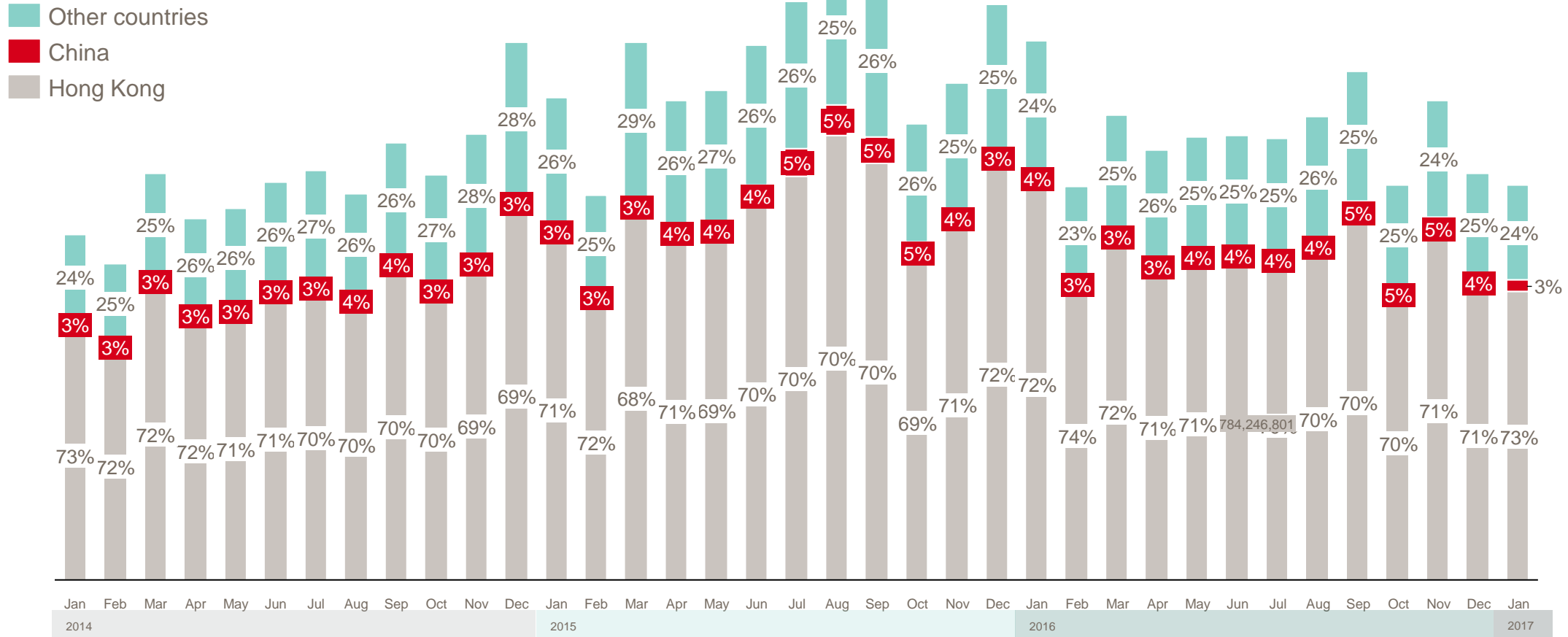
Customer initiated and institutional payments. Inbound + Outbound traffic. Based on value.
